



## Terms for the scholarship

### **ALTE Paris 2014 Scholarship from Cambridge English Language Assessment**

**A new scholarship gives the opportunity for any teacher involved in English language education to attend the ALTE 5<sup>th</sup> International Conference 2014.**

The scholarship is funded by Cambridge English Language Assessment.

#### **The award consists of:**

- 2-day registration for the conference
- maximum of 3 nights' accommodation
- travel costs including, if necessary, an economy return flight to France\*
- €60.00 per day expenses

\*This includes the cost of return flight and airport transfers. The award does not cover the costs of stopovers.

#### **To qualify you must:**

- work or be studying in the fields of language learning, teaching and assessment
- never have attended an ALTE International Conference previously

#### **To be considered for the scholarship:**

- your submission should be between 500 and 1000 words on the subject of:

We will judge the answers on the basis of their originality, relevance to your professional experience and insight into language learning, teaching and assessment.

#### **And provide:**

- a brief curriculum vitae (2 sides A4 maximum)
- a passport size photograph
