## Permanent deletion of an empty class

For teachers

### What's new?

Teachers can now permanently delete an empty class that has no students, other teachers, groups, assignments, content access rules, or grading scales added to it.

Deleted empty classes completely disappear from the teacher's dashboard as well as from the administrator's dashboard of the associated school. These permanently deleted classes cannot be restored.

### The benefits


Deleting empty classes that are not needed any more or were created by mistake will help teachers declutter their dashboard without any risk of losing important data. As before, any deleted classes that are not completely empty will appear in the 'Ended classes' section of the teacher's dashboard (for independent teachers) or the administrator's dashboard (in a school account).

### How does it work?

#### Deleting a class

School and independent teachers should select the 'Delete class' option on the 'Actions' menu of the class page of an empty class:
