## Locking student access after assignment due date and tests access management

For teachers

#### What's new?

Teachers will now be able to restrict students' access to content (practice activities and tests) after assignment on them ends.


They will also be able to create a schedule of locking/unlocking rules for test components (this capability was already in place for practice content).

#### The benefits

The improvement allows teachers to easily restrict students' access to test and practice content outside of a defined completion window, preventing late submissions and ensuring more reliable scoring.

#### How does it work?

- When creating an assignment, teachers can now select a setting, requesting to lock access to assignment content after the due date.
- The feature applies to all lockable content types —
  including both practice and test components and
  is especially useful for teachers who don't use a
  detailed lock/unlock schedule.
- Teachers will also still be able to use the 'Manage student access' feature on their Materials page to set up content access rules for their classes. The capability is now extended to tests.
