Creating classes without a teacher

Update: For Administrators

What's new?

Previously classes had to include a teacher when being created. This was an issue for Administrators who needed to create classes before teachers were appointed. This requirement to have a teacher has now been removed from Cambridge One. This means that new classes can now be created without a teacher and that the last teacher in the class can also be removed from existing classes.

The benefits

- Ability to create a new class and add a teacher at a later date
- Ability to remove the last teacher from a class

How does it work?

In the 'Create new classes' form, the teacher column is now optional.

How it looks

It now has 'Teacher/s (Optional)'.
