We offer classes to students from 7-years-old through to adults. We offer different options from 7.5 to 30 hours for weekday classes, and 3 hours and above for our Saturday classes.

Due to the high volume of classes we manage monthly, we designed class templates which incorporate all the different tools at our disposal, such as access rules, assignment settings and class grade settings.

Admins set study content for Evolve, and homework assignments for Empower. Both courses use the ready-made Unit Progress Tests and Competency Tests in Cambridge One.

Teachers track their students' progress on the platform and give personalized feedback and advice on what content to review and consolidate. Our Venue Academic Coordinators and Deputy CEO rely on the reports we generate to manage students' grades, analyse the results and make strategic academic decisions.

Evolve: Teachers make good use of the tools in the Teacher's Companion and Resources to design engaging and dynamic lessons. Students learn independently in the Student Course and assess the learning in the Unit Progress Tests.
